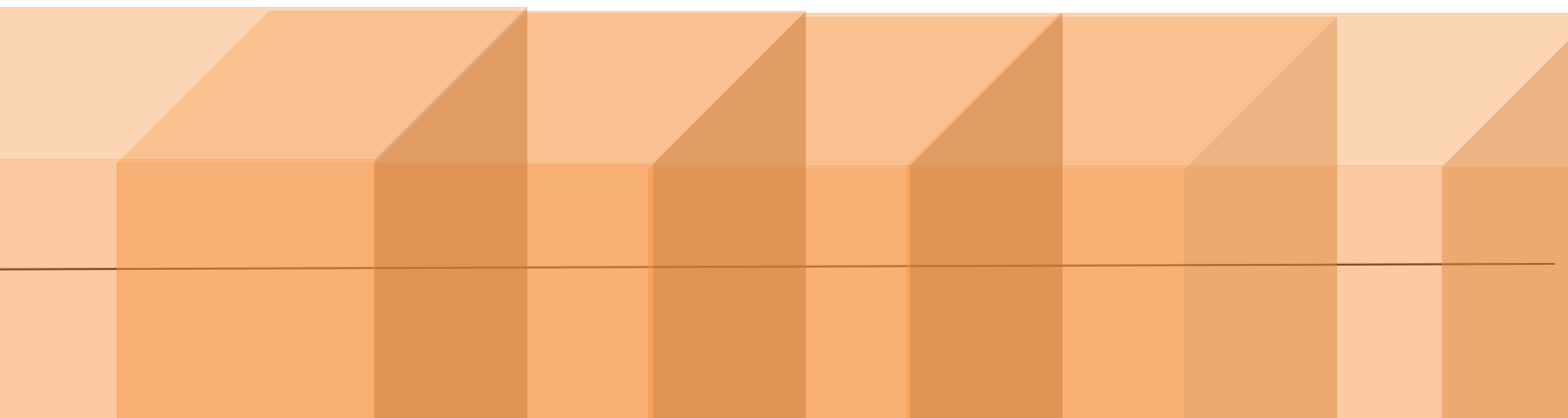

## About the College:

Birla College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Kalyan, was established in 1972, by Kalyan Citizens' Education Society with the blessings of Syt. B. K. Birla ji and Late Smt. Sarla ji Birla.

Now, the College is in its 44<sup>th</sup> year of existence and has achieved several milestones in the course of its journey.

*B. K. Birla College of Arts, Science and Commerce (Autonomous), Kalyan* a multi-faculty premier institution of higher learning, with an enrolment of more than 7,000 students (for UG, PG and Research Programmes) is affiliated to the University of Mumbai (UoM). In addition, more than 4000 students are in Junior College Unit.

*The College has started a Community College for Diploma in Accounting and Taxation (sanctioned by UGC) from 2015 – 16.*

The College is spread over an area of 20 acres of land (including Birla School) in the prime location of Kalyan city and developed as an eco-friendly campus.

## College Achievements:

The College has been reaccredited (3<sup>rd</sup> Cycle) in 2014 and awarded 'A' Grade with CGPA 3.58. The College has been the winner of IMC - RBNQ *Performance Excellence Trophy - 2011 in Education*. The College has been conferred with the '*Best College Award*' in the urban category, by the University of Mumbai in 2009. It is ISO 9001:2008 certified. The Recertification Audit of ISO 9001: 2008 was completed successfully by TUV- NORD in August 2016. College has started the process of upgradation for ISO 9001:2015.

Recently, the College has been bestowed with '*College of Excellence*' status (2015-2020) by UGC. Earlier the College was identified as '*College with Potential for Excellence*' (CPE) in 2010 by the UGC. It received a grant of Rs. 1.00 Cr. under CPE which has been utilized for improving academic infrastructure and adopting innovations in teaching, learning and evaluation. The College has again received a grant of Rs. 1.6 Cr. under CE from UGC.

The College also receives funds from DST under FIST scheme and from DBT under Star College scheme to strengthen teaching and research facilities in the departments of science faculty.



The RUSA has sanctioned our College a grant of Rs. 5.00 cr. for 'Enhancing Quality and Excellence'.

Recently the college has been approved as a Potential 'Mentor Institution', by UGC under PARAMARSH scheme (2019-20).

## **NCC :**

- NCC at B. K. Birla College is one of the most important activities instrumental in the personality development of the Students. Probably College has maximum strength of enrolled cadets in the country i. e. 350 cadets. There are 100 cadets in Army Boys wing (6 Mah. Bn. NCC), 80 cadets in Army Girls wing AAA(1 Mah. (G) Bn.) and 150 Cadets (100 boys and 50 girls) in Naval wings (1 Mah. Naval Unit NCC). In addition to this 20 Cadets have been enrolled in 1 Mah. Air Sqn (open unit). Accordingly, there are 4 Associate NCC Officers (ANOs) and 02 Care Taker Officers, to take care of these units. It has maintained a high standard of Character and Discipline.

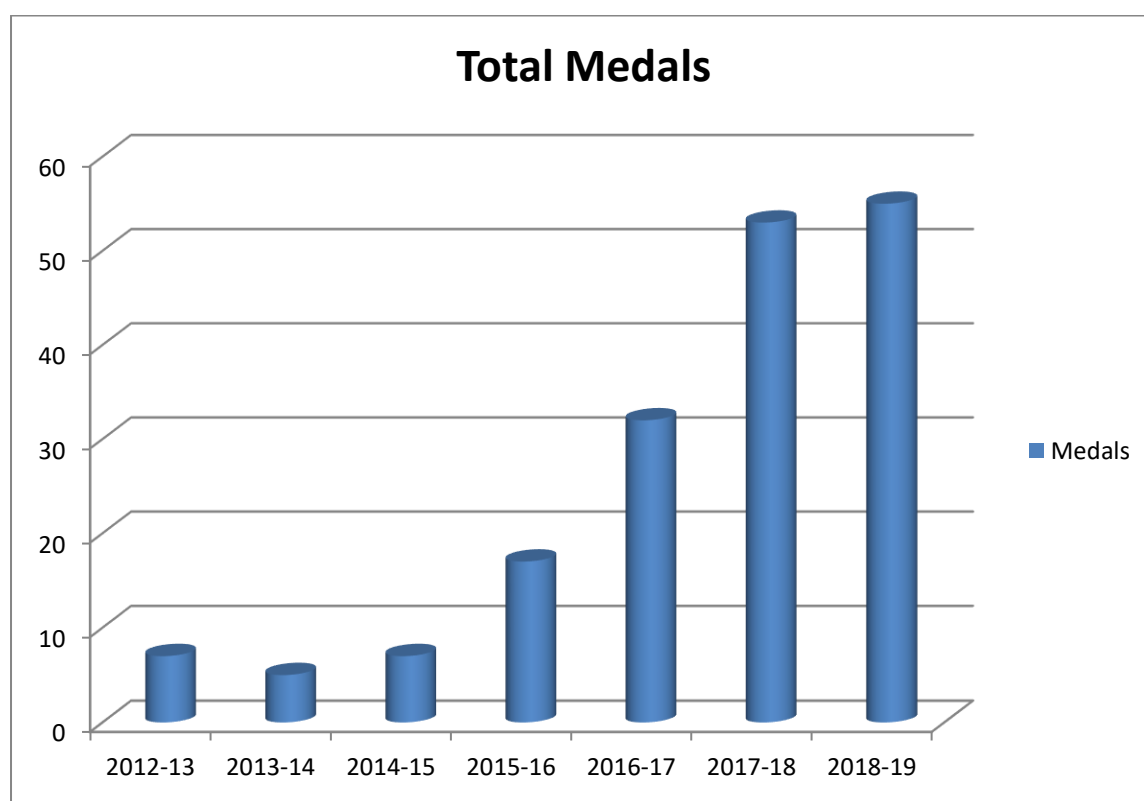




### **E. Other Imp Event:**

### **Arts Circle:**

Arts Circle is the cultural club of college which provides the platform for all the students to showcase and enhance their talent. The main objective of this club is to make new avenues available to the students in the field of performance, literary and fine art.

**Events organized by Arts circle during academic year 2018-19 are as follows:**



- On the occasion of **Gyan Dindi** art circle students have performed cultural show in Birla Mandir, shahad on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 18.
- **Talent hunt** was conducted on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2018 to identify new talents of students in the various art forms in order to create new talent pool. Nearly two hundred students were screened during this event.
- On 14<sup>th</sup> August, 2018 class wise performances like singing, dancing, poem recitation, etc were conducted by the students during their second and third lecture to celebrate **Pre-Independence Day**. Students from Arts circle presented a cultural show on the main stage with the theme of 'National Integration'. Approximately 75 students participated in the final show performed on the main stage.

### **UGC sponsored Women's Studies Centre (WSC) & Women Development Cell (WDC):**

UGC Sponsored Women's Studies Centre and Women Development Cell conduct activities throughout the academic year keeping in mind the objective: *to be a catalyst for active promotion of women's learning through sustained engagements, superior understanding of needs and knowledge sharing with a feminist perspective.*

- A Zumba Dance Workshop was conducted on 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2018 by Ms. Akansha and Team. It was a workshop for girls and was attended by 56 students. The main aim of the workshop was to show girls how a fun and interesting activity like dance can serve as a form of exercise to maintain physical and mental health. The students learnt the basic dance routines as well as a few routines targeted towards better physical health.
- A 1-Credit Certificate Course on Creative Skills was organized on 18th to 24th August, 2018. The 15-hour course included instruction and practice on various forms of art such as Rakhi Making, Sanskaar Bharti Rangoli, Yarn and Wool



Rangoli, Diya Painting, 3D- Acrylic Rangoli as well as Mehendi Design. Experts were invited to interact with the students and give them hands on training.

- A series of Intercollegiate Competitions were held on 24th September, 2018. An Essay Competition, Best Out of Waste and Poster Competition were conducted and saw a very good response and participation of more than 200 students in total. Students from various local colleges participated in large numbers. The three best entries in each competition were given cash prizes and certificates.
