**I. Chairman of the Meeting:**

Mr. O. R. Chitlange, President and Chairman of the Society, occupied the chair.

**II. Leave of Absence:**

Mr. M. Zojwala, Mr. Pramod Hindurao, Prin. A. P. Pradhan and Mr. Kapil Pathare expressed their inability to attend the meeting. Accordingly, they were granted leave of absence.

National / International conferences / seminars / webinars / workshops on frontier research topics is regularly organised. Encouraging publication of research outcomes in reputed national/international journals lead the faculty members to enhance their research activity. Partial financial assistance, special leave granted to faculty members to attend conferences at national/international level. Infrastructural development, creation of sophisticated instrument laboratories, computational facilities are provided to upgrade research centers. The college provides best facilities with instruments like XRD, FTIR, RT-PCR etc. Department of Environmental Sciences' laboratory has been accredited by National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL) to provide consultancy services for analysis of industrial effluent samples. College has well equipped central library for primary / secondary sources in humanities, science and commerce and management. College has 24 research guides, and 9 Ph.D. Centers recognized by University of Mumbai. College encourages collaborative research with reputed national / international institutions.
